## Beers on tap (33cl)



### Sunday's Brew 8+

Pilsner  
Rye & Pint (Singapore)  
5.0%  
Local favorite. Refreshing and tasty Pilsner with initial citrus and floral notes, rounding off with a malty finish.



### Delirium Tremens 12+

Golden Tripel  
Huyghe (Belgium)  
8.5%  
Voted "Best Beer in the World"! This iconic Pink Elephant brew pours a golden colour with a striking bouquet of spice, citrus and bananas, with a good follow-through in the palate where notes of cloves and sweet fruits (orange, pineapples, bananas) unfold with each mouthful.

### Kriek Boon 8+

Fruit Lambic  
Huyghe (Belgium)

The cherries and young lambic create a red-coloured beer that is both natural and fresh, with an absolutely memorable sweet and sour taste with lively carbonation. This is cherry-esque as it should be, with nothing but real cherries (25%) and 6-month-old lambic. Subtle Bitter sweet flavors make this a perfect dessert pairing.

## Craft Beer

### Priarie Standard (35cl) 10+

Saison  
Oklahoma (U.S.A.)  
5.6%  
Delicious everyday beer with crisp notes of pale malt, light caramel, light spring flowers and fruits. Seasonal farmhouse ale with a hoppy finish. Soft carbonation and medium body with character and moderate complexity.



### Innis & Gunn Original (33cl) 9+

Scottish Ale  
Innis & Gunn (U.K.)  
6.6%  
This honey-hued beer is matured over the finest American Oak heartwood to unlock natural flavours from deep within the oak grain. These luscious flavours of toffee, vanilla and oak perfectly balance the beer's malt backbone and light hop fruitiness.



### Op & Top (33cl) 9+

IPA  
De Molen (Netherlands)  
4.5%  
Bright floral hop aromas with touches of citrus grapefruit and bready malt. Juicy fruit flavours backed by malt sweetness with a light, dry finish, making this an excellent drinkability in our hot weather.

### Rochefort 8 (33cl) 12+

Trappist Dark Ale  
Rochefort (Belgium)  
9.2%  
Dull-bodied and deeply flavored dark ale. The aroma has gentle notes of stone fruits, caramel, spiced dryness, leather, and figs which provides a good contrast to its vigorous and complex body.

### Westmalle Tripel (33cl) 14+

Trappist Tripel  
Westmalle (Belgium)  
9.5%  
Westmalle beers possess the intoxicating fragrance of vanilla and more. Complex with apricot, banana and peppery notes on the palate and a soft bitterness.

### Oude Geuze Boon (37.5cl) 14+

Lambic Beer  
Lembeek (Belgium)  
7.0%  
Traditional-style 100% spontaneous fermentation Lambic style brew. Aged 3 years. Smells of funky lemon and barnyard spices. Acidic tart & slightly sour with a refreshing finish. Incredible complement with complex-flavored seafood (Lobsters!) and deep fried rich dishes.

### Crabbies Original Ginger Beer (33cl)

Curiously spicy yet deliciously refreshing blend of real steeped ginger and exotic spices. Organic & gluten free.

### Magic Hat #9 (35.5cl) 9+

Golden Orange! Dry, crisp & refreshing pale ale. Floral Scents with apricot & malt flavors. Champagnesque levels of carbonation.

### Pannepot Reserva (33cl) 18+

Belgian Strong Ale aged in Oak Barrels 24 months  
De Struise (Belgium)  
10%  
Aged 14 months in French Oak cask, the Pannepot Reserva is a hazy dark beer between a Belgian strong dark ale and a stout with tanned head with complex flavours of oak, caramel, dark stone fruits and coffee. It is a complex beer that develops with every subsequent taste. Vintage.

### Pannepot Grand Reserva (33cl) 18+

Strong Ale aged in Calvados Oak Barrels  
De Struise (Belgium)  
10%  
Aged 24 months in French Oak cask before finishing it Calvados oak barrels, the Pannepot Grand Reserva is an intensively complex beer. Expect to start with light and moderately sweet notes with wood and fruity sourness upon your initial taste before notes of dark fruits with notes of plums and a little cherry, toffee and some slight chocolate develops as the beer matures in the glass.



### Lindeman's Framboise (25cl) 8+

Magnificent aroma of freshly-picked raspberries and undertones of fruit acidity. Lovely with chocolate desserts and all sweet ice creams.



### Lindeman's Apple (25cl) 8+
