The ur-tequila. When alcoholic Spanish conquistadors started running out of brandy, they began distilling a sacred, fermented agave-based drink the natives called pulque, and mezcal was born. Made from many varieties of agave, traditional mezcal preparation involves roasting the "piñas" (the hearts of the agave) in stone pits covered in dirt, which lends it its distinctive smokey flavor. Mezcal is divisive: you'll either love it or hate it. But there's only one way to know for sure.
