Red Dry

Saperavi -13% - £32.90 / £9.50

The wine has a rich deep pomegranate colour, It has a strongly developed, complex bouquet and a balanced, harmonious taste.

Saperavi Kondoli £50.90 / £12.90

Complex and rich nose with cherry, black prune, blackberry and dried fruits integrated with toasted oak notes.

The initial palate starts with black fruit and vanilla aromas, goes on with an elegant, aromatic and soft mid palate.

The aftertaste is long and spicy with touch of oak, supported by silky

Mukuzani - 13% - £35.90 / £10.050

This deep ruby coloured Mukuzani is characterised with blackberry, black plum and pepper aromas with a long lasting finish.

Tavkvery - 13% - £56.90/ £15.90

Intense red colour. Subtle bouquet of red fruit paired with floral and spicy notes. Smooth expression of red fruits and sweet aromas. Crispy freshness and medium, soft palate.

Shavkapito - 13% - £56.90/ £15.90

Has a lovely ruby colour. Rich bouquet of jammy blueberry and black cherry, accompanied by cinnamon notes. Well - structured, medium bodied with long crisp finish.

Saperavi - 13% - £58.00 ♦

Saperavi is made with 100% Saperavi grapes, grown in the appellation Tsinandali, Kakheti Region. It is created in the old Georgian method in Qvevri, beeswax-coated terracotta pots buried in the earth, where alcohol and malolactic fermentations occur spontaneously with thirty days skin contact

Mukuzani - 13% - £58.00 ♦

This deep ruby coloured Mukuzani is characterised with blackberry, black cherry, black plum and pepper aromas blended with vanilla and tobacco notes creating a long lasting finish. The grapes are macerated with skin, pips and 15% stalks for three weeks and the grape juice is transferred to another qvevri for two months and then moved again to age in French oak barrels for a further 4 months.

Red Dry

Bottle 750ml / Glass 175ml / Shot 50ml

Rachuli Saperavi 12% - £65.00 🍷

Made in mountainous Racha region of Georgia from Saperavi grapes in Qvevry. Wine is deep dark ruby colour with high tannin and medium acidity. Well balanced wine is full-body and meanwhile elegant. It has pronounced flavour intensity of black fruit, blackberry, black plum, dark berry and elderberry with memorable long finish.

Satrapezo - 12.5% - £110.00 🍷

Deep red color with bricky line on the rim. Black fruit flavors and ripe silky oak tannins are dominant on the initial palate. The middle palate is round, full and soft. Fresh, clean black currant flavors and liquorice notes are balanced by attractive oak and ripe grape-tannin complexity.

Marani Reserve 2007 - £13.5 / £150 .00

Made from Saperai grapes. Flavour is soft, elegant and silky, invading your palate with creamy flavors of red fruit, sweet spices, leather and blond tobacco. The finish is long and spicy supported again by smooth and ripe tannin. Aroma intense, offering aromas of cherry liquor, red fruit jam and a beautiful spicy-smoky-earthy bouquet as a result of perfect maturation.

Red Semi-Dry

Pirosmani - 12.5% - £ 34.90/ £9.50

Medium dry wine made from Saperavi grapes. It has an intense ruby colour. It has notes of red cherry and hint of prunes. Taste is full with incredibly long well balanced finish.

Rose Dry

Saperavi Rose 13% - £ 34.90/ £9.50

Made with saperai grapes. Aromas of pomegranate and barberry are combined with peach and raspberry. The taste is crisp and elegant, with the bunch of flavors repeating the nose. The mid palate is silky and round ending with lively rose petal and well balanced aftertaste.

Red Semi-Sweet

Ojaleshi - 11% - £36.00/ £10.50

Light ruby color. The taste is light and elegant, traditional for this wine, prevailed by red fruits and some herbaceous overtones. Finish is delicate and persistent with candied raspberry and mild acidity.

Red Semi-Sweet

Kindzmarauli - 11.5% - £36.00 / £10.50

Sweet blackberry and black cherry confiture are prevailing the initial palate. Mid palate is full and chewy, with slightly rough tannins. Finish is lingering with lively acidity and sweet and fruity aftertaste

Khvanchkara - 11.5% - £36.00/ £10.50

The wine is form Khvanchkara Specific Viticulture area. The complex aromas of red fruit, dominated by Raspberry, Strawberry with some notes of roasted almonds

White Dry

Tsinandali - 13% - £34.90 / £9.50

Full bodied, elegant, complex and round, with banana and tropical fruit at the initial palate is perfectly balanced by fresh citric finish with some oaky notes.

Rkatsiteli - 12.5% - £32.90 / £9.50

Refined and full bodied, with light oak touch, lingering zesty finish and buttery aftertaste

Goruli Mtsvane- 12.5% - £55.00 / £15.50

Light straw colour. Subtle bouquet with floral notes, white and yellow plums, gooseberries and citrus fruits. The palate is elegant, with floral and fruity aromas.

Mtsvane & Kisi 13% - £46.90 / £12.50

Blend of Mtsvane and Kisi grapes compose a natural marriage of fresh, leafy and flower blossom from Mtsvane and rich tropical fruits, pineapple and ripe plums aromas from Kisi. It has a floral and white peach flavors. Mid-palate is rich with creamy layers of mango, peach and pineapple lingers in an elegant and racy finish.

Tsolikauri 12.5% - £38.00/ £10.50

Made from Imeruli grape variety Tsolikauri. It has a taste is lively acid, fresh and fruity with multiple fruit palette, dominant by banana, pear and apples. The finish is long and persistent, accompanied by different spices and cinnamon. It has aromas of white and yellow fruits.

White Semi-Sweet

Tvishi - 12.5% - £36.00 / £10.50

Beautifully fresh and zesty, with notes of quince and pear. Crisp and clean aftertaste brings back once more fruity and floral aromas

Alazani Valley- 12% - £36.00 / £10.50

It has an intriguing bouquet of toasted nuts and ripe apples with the touch of quince and melon. The taste is fresh with mild acidity and gently sweet and rounded with dominant notes of candied quince peel.

Amber Wine

Rkatsiteli - 13% - £55.00 🍷

Rkatsiteli is a sturdy grape hence it is most widely spread white grape in Georgia, mainly cultivated in Kakheti and Kartli. This wine bright straw-coloured wine has subtle floral aromas with notes of citrus, quince and apple.

Kisi - 14% - £55.00 🍷

This wine is made from the Kisi (100%) grape variety grown in Tsinandali village in Kakheti. Kisi is a low yielding grape. Kisi is made according to the Kakhetian traditional winemaking method in Qvevri with 6 months skin contact and just 15% stalks and pips. This amber coloured wine is easily recognised by its dry apricot and quince aromas with hazelnut notes.

Mtsvane -14.5% - £55.00 🍷

The Mtsvane grape is one of the 525 indigenous grape varieties from Georgia, which is fermented in qvevri, complete with skins, seeds and stems to enhance the wine's robust tannin-rich flavour. This exceptional Mtsvane is aged in the qvevri giving it a unique deep amber brilliance. This wine is unfiltered, so some sediment is expected. Enjoy the fragrance of fully ripe dry figs and quince jam, stable and silky with strong velvety and long-lasting tannins.

Khikhvi - 14% - £55.00 🍷

This wine is made using the traditional Georgian method in Qvevri with 100% Khikhvi grapes cultivated in the Shumi Winery estate vineyards in Kakheti. This amber hued wine has a well balanced silky, mild tannic structure with aromas of white cherry, peach and ripe pears. Shumi's Khikhvi is characterised with a prolonged lingering finish.

Made from Rcatsiteli grapes. Flavors are complex with dried apricots, pears, sweet spices light vanilla and coconut notes. The finish is long and silky, with soft and mature tannins. Very complex aromas of white fruit marmalade, with cinnamon, rose petals and toasted almonds.
