Our story

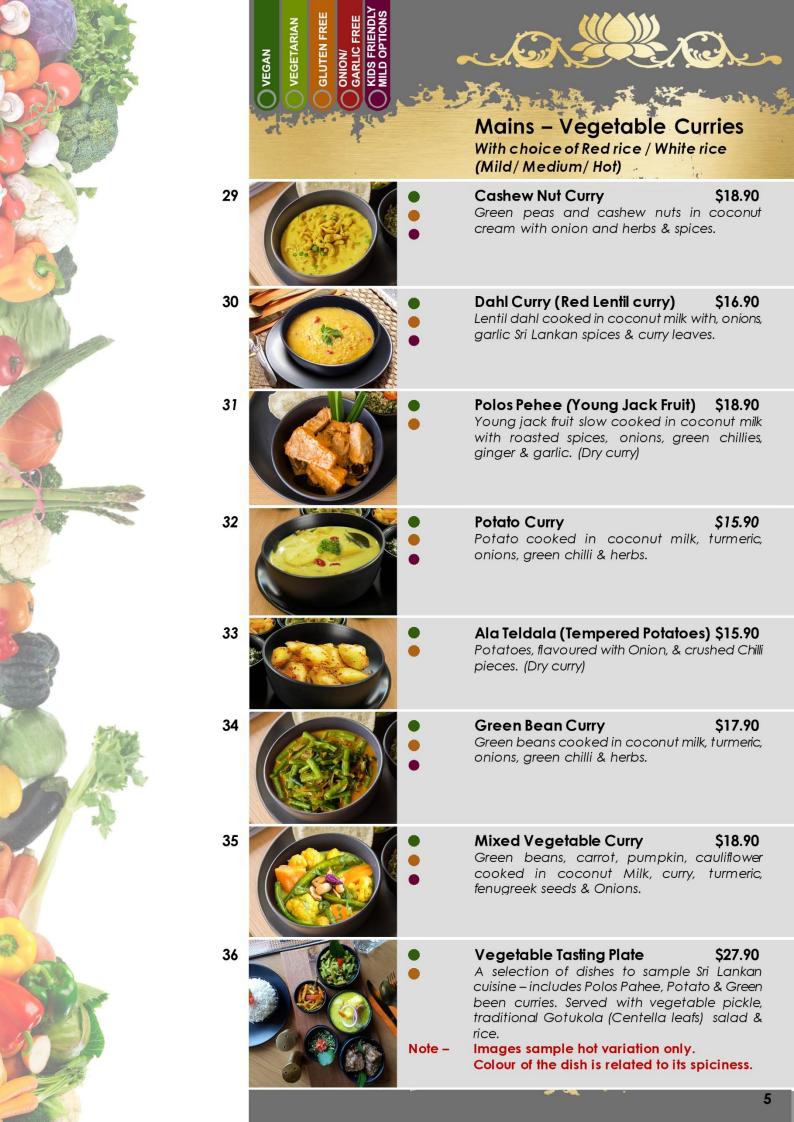

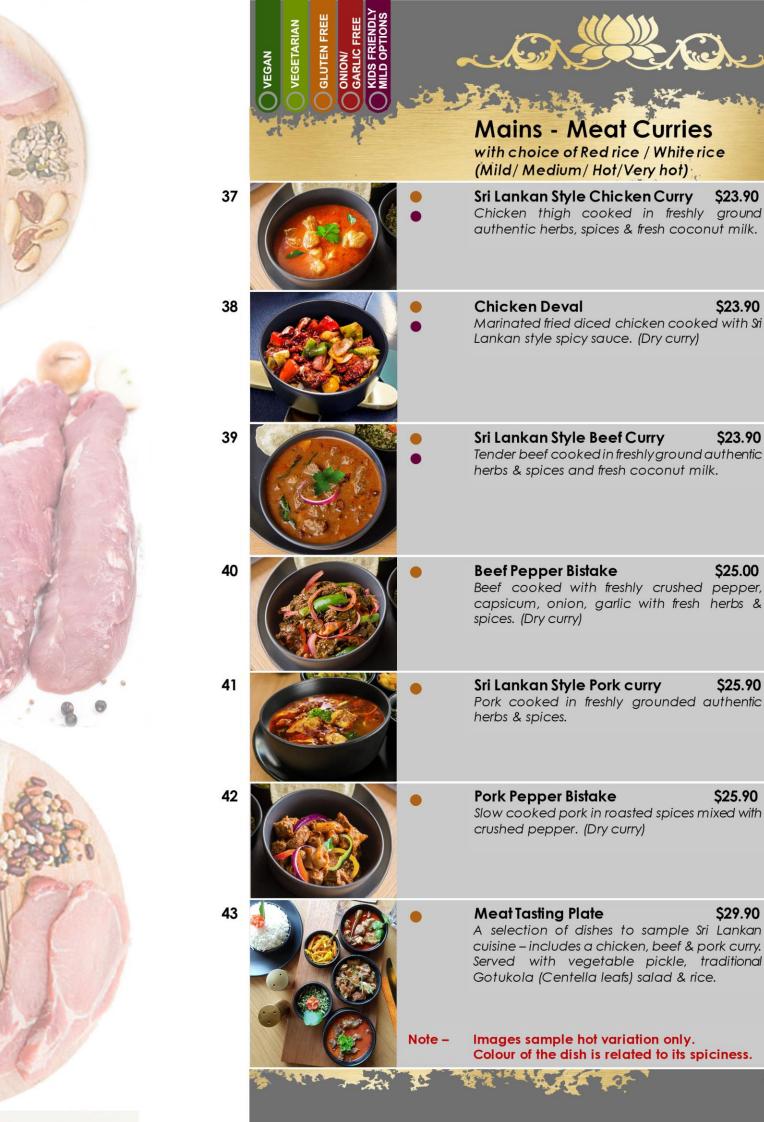

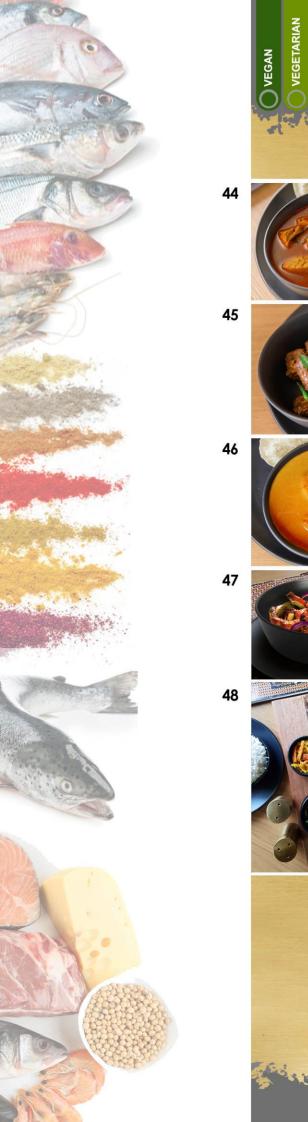
