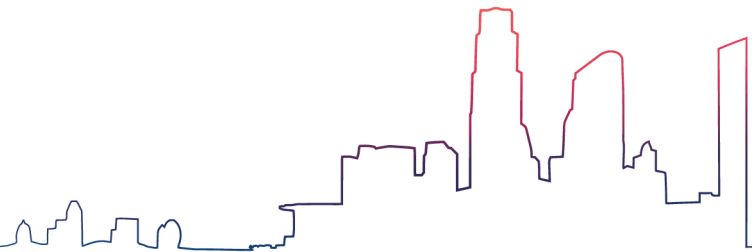

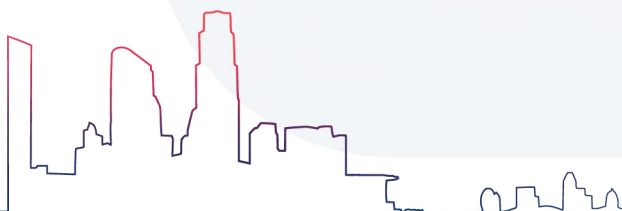

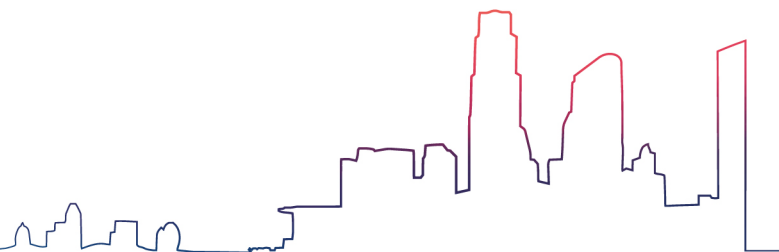

### Mission Sud Cabernet Syrah IGP OC

78

Alcohol: 13.5% Region: Languedoc-Roussillon, France Grape Varieties: Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah

#### Tasting Notes:

A rich and full-bodied profile, with a deep ruby color and robust flavors. The nose reveals intense aromas of blackberries, black currants, and plum, intertwined with subtle notes of spice, leather, and a touch of smokiness. Well-structured on the palate, a harmonious blend of ripe dark fruits, hints of pepper, and a velvety tannin texture. The mid-palate is bold yet smooth, leading to a long, elegant finish with lingering notes of dark chocolate and vanilla.

### Brunilde Di Menzione Primitivo Di Manduria DOC

Alcohol: 14.5% Region: Manduria, Puglia, Italy Grapes Variety: 100% Primitivo

#### Tasting Notes:

A deep ruby red color with garnet hues, showing its richness and maturity. The nose reveals intense aromas of ripe blackberries, plums, and dark cherries, subtle hints of chocolate and spice. A full-bodied and smooth palate, flavors of jammy black fruits, licorice, and a touch of black pepper, balanced by soft tannins. The finish is long and warm, leaving lingering notes of dried fruit and cocoa.

### Limited Edition 10 Vendemmie N.V., Tenuta Uliss

Alcohol: 14.5% Region: DOC Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Abruzzo, Italy Grapes Variety: Montepulciano

#### Tasting Notes:

A fresh and youthful nose with remarkable complexity. An intense mix of dark and red fruits, grape, orange, graphite on a background of salty caramel, earthiness and fennel. As the wine starts breathing, a wealth of spices like mastic, liquorice, allspice, and mahalepi is revealed. A unique structure and finesse with exceptional balance. Full bodied with high acidity and high silky tannins. The finish is complex and lingering.

### RIPASSO SUPERIORE DOC CLASSICO 2019

Alcohol: 13.5% Region: Veneto, Italy Grapes Variety: Corvina, Rondinella, and Molinara

#### Tasting Notes:

This wine is fermented on the skins of Amarone grapes according to the ancient technique of "Ripasso". Following subsequent aging in oak barrels for a period of 12 months, it is aged in the bottle for another 6 months. This Ripasso is a luxurious ruby red with intense hints of spice and red fruits. It has a velvety and full body with soft tannins and an elegant finish. As the wine breathes, it reveals hues of cinnamon, herbs and leather.

### Renato Ratti Barolo Marcenasco 2018

Alcohol: 14% Region: PIEMONTE, ITALY Grapes Variety: NEBBIOLO

#### Tasting Notes:

Marcenasco is the classic Barolo of Ratti, a blend of several vineyards in Annunziata and La Morra; while it does display the typical round tannins of this commune, it is lighter on the palate and leaner in its finish than the winery's two single vineyard Barolo. The aromas are highlighted by notes of morello cherry, wild strawberry, redcurrant and cumin, while brown spice notes dominate the finish.

Alcohol: 11% Region: France Grapes Variety: Sauvignon Blanc

#### Tasting Notes:

This white wine presents a pale yellow color with a slight greenish hue, indicating its freshness. The nose is bright and aromatic, offering citrus notes of lemon and lime, complemented by subtle hints of green apple and white flowers. On the palate, it is crisp and light, with refreshing acidity that brings out flavors of citrus, pear, and a touch of minerality. The mid-palate is smooth and well-balanced, providing a lively mouthfeel. The finish is clean and zesty, leaving a refreshing, fruity aftertaste. Its vibrant acidity makes it an excellent choice for easy sipping.

### Txakoli Primo (Spain) White Txakoli (Sparkling)

Alcohol: 11.5% Region: Spain Grapes Variety: Hondarribi Zuri

#### Tasting Notes:

Txakoli is Spain's answer to Vinho Verde, but a drier and with a dash more spritz. Txakoli is a young and fruity wine of modest alcohol, balancing acidity, and medium carbonation. Pure, clean, racy, spritzy, and packed with truly mouth-watering acidity and lemon/lime freshness, this wine springs around your mouth like crazy, showing you bitter lemon, tart melon, almond...all in a light, piquant, salty-sea-air kind of way that just says: "let's party". As a tiny column of bubbles dissipates in the glass, lemon, fresh basil and nasturtium aromas waft upward. Lemon, Valencia orange and lime zest flavors are joined by notes of chopped basil, parsley and lavender that linger into an incandescent finish.

### Champagne Gerbaux Extra Brut, L'Empreinte de Raymond

Alcohol: 12% Region: Marne Valley Champagne, France Grapes Variety: 20% Chardonnay, 30% Pinot Noir, 50% Meunier

#### Tasting Notes:

This extra brut champagne reveals a vibrant and refined palate, characterized by its crisp acidity and delicate mousse. Aromas of green apple, citrus, and brioche are complemented by subtle notes of almond and white flowers. On the palate, it showcases flavors of lemon zest, pear, and a hint of minerality, leading to a long, clean finish. Its well-balanced dryness makes it a perfect aperitif or a versatile pairing with seafood and light appetizers. The complexity and finesse of this champagne reflect the meticulous craftsmanship of the Gerbaux family.
