Many legends are related to the sunny Georgia. One of them tells a story of creation of Georgia.

In the beginning of times God gave to every nation their own piece of land. Georgians were late and arrived only when all the land was divided. When God asked where were georgians, they told that on the way they stopped to eat and to drink some wine and make toasts. One toast was said also in honor of God. All the land had already been divided and God had a dilemma, what to give to georgians. He liked their answer and that they were such joyful nation so much, that he decided to give them the best piece of land, which he was saving for himself.

Long meal time and toasts are a big part of Georgian food culture, and especially in Supra, a traditional georgian feast. Several starters and main courses can be enjoyed at the table. Dishes are served on big plates where everyone can take anything they want on their own plate. Mountain regions, warm beaches of the Black Sea, different nations in the country – all have their own food traditions. At the same time they drink wine and make long toasts led by the oldest Tamada. Archaeological findings reveal that Georgia has been the cradle of wine making.

Georgian House restaurant wants to give you an opportunity to get to know the hospitality of Georgia, the rich and versatile food- and wine culture. Vegetables, herbs, spices and nuts are main ingredients in many dishes. Bread is an essential part of the meal. And to top it all, a good georgian wine. Many of georgians favorite wines, e.g. Kindzmarauli, may be a bit too sweet for the european taste, but we recommend to taste it for Aperitif or for dessert. Enjoying with food most prefer traditional Saperavi.

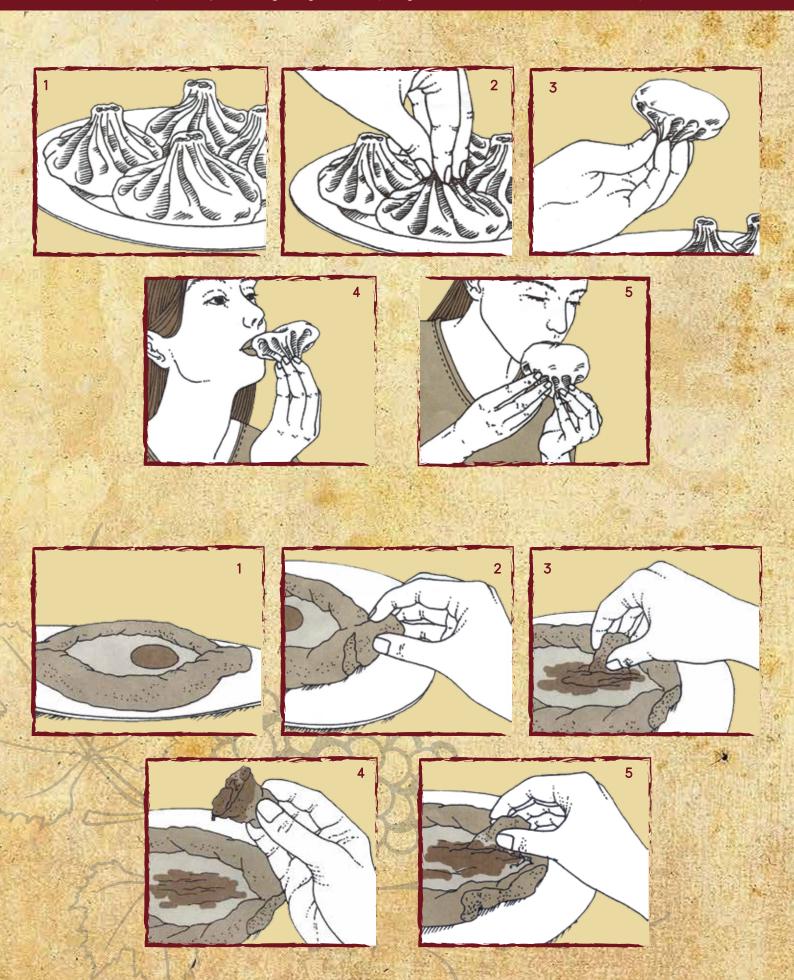
