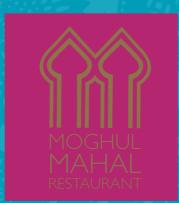

CHAI

Chai is an everyday beverage for Indian and other Asian households. It is sold wherever people gather, such as trains, bus stations and marketplaces. The chai vendors (wallahs) brew their tea in huge kettles over small charcoal fires. The chai is served in unglazed terra cotta pots or saucers called "kullarhs" which the wallah may have actually made himself over an open fire. The unglazed pots impart an earthy flavor to the chai. Part of this "chai ritual" involves smashing the pots after drinking.
