– Champagne, Grape Varietals - Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier

Full freshness, fines and elegance. Its colour is yellow gold, delicate and shiny. It displays beautiful fine and persistent bubbles. The nose of this champagne is very refined. The prevailing flavours are fruity and light like citrus, pear, apricot... On the palate, the Laurent-Perrier Brut is supple with a remarkable balance, offering endlessly renewed flavours

– Soave, Grape Varietals – Garganega

Straw color nose of pineapple. Light bodied slightly creamy mouthfeel with high acidity and notes of green apple and white peach and a dry mid finish

– Chablis, Burgundy, Grape Varietals – Chardonnay

Lovely bouquet of citrus blossom, lemon, pear, and quince. Palate explodes with starfruit and a chalk like finish. Mouth-watering acidity, with a rounded feel

Very elegant wine with a lot of personality. Great fruity structure, medium body, nice salinity and long finish

– Rheinhessen, Grape Varietals – Riesling

Bright and Transparent. Intensive lime zest, grapefruit and kiwi aromas on the nose. Lemon, ripe banana and lychee flavours on the palate. Refreshing and a tad acidic, but overall well balanced

– Marlborough, Grape Varietals – Sauvignon Blanc

Crisp, tropical, grapefruit, citrus, green apple, grass, minerals. Nicely balanced NZ SB with the right amount of acidity and a pleasant finish

- R1. Château D'Arthus 2013 Grand Cru** *3.8 Vivino Rating **\$70.00**
– Saint-Émilion, Grape Varietals – Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Merlot
Deep dark red cherry. Nose - medium intensity. Palate – Medium dry acidity. Very rich, full bodied and well rounded
- R2. Xavier Vignon, GIGONDAS 2015** *3.8 Vivino Rating **\$78.00**
– Gigondas, Southern Rhône, Grape Varietals – Grenache, Mourvèdre
The 2015 Gigondas is a more medium-bodied, pretty wine that has an approachable feel in its ripe plum, blueberry fruits, violets, peppery herb aromas. It has supple tannin and good mid-palate depth
- R3. Xavier Vignon, Rouge 2016** *3.6 Vivino Rating **\$49.00**
– Cote du Rhône, Southern Rhône, Grape Varietals - Syrah, Mourvedre, Grenache
Deep ruby, black fruit and ripe plums on nose, high tannins and acidity, tart red fruits, cranberry, blackberries, long finish
- R4. Argiano, Brunello Di Montalcino 2014** *4.1 Vivino Rating **\$128.00**
– Brunello di Montalcino, Grape Varietals – Sangiovese
The wine is clean on the nose with a medium intensity of cherries and violets. On the palate the wine is dry with high acidity, medium+ body, medium flavour intensity. The tannins are very smooth
- R5. Castello Del Trebbio, Superiore 2017 DOCG** *3.7 Vivino Rating **\$51.00**
– Chianti Classico, Grape Varietals – Sangiovese
A deep ruby red color with aromas of small berries and hints of flowers and spice. Medium bodied with velvety tannins and pleasant acidity
- R6. Siglo, Gran Reserva 2009** *3.9 Vivino Rating **\$91.00**
– Rioja, Grape Varietals – Tempranillo, Graciano, Garnacha
Full bodied, medium plus acidity and high tannins. Fresh fruit flavours are mostly gone, it show notes of plum, cooked fruit, leather, prune, tobacco, clove, pepper, dust, meat and raisins, with long finish.
- R7. Elderton, Shiraz 2016** *3.5 Vivino Rating **\$48.00**
– Barossa Valley, Grape Varietals – Shiraz
Cool minty nose, with a chocolate wood undertone. Very powerful on the palate with broad tannins, and very intense. Blackberry, cassis, mint, oak, cocoa coffee.
- R8. Saint Clair Pinot Noir 2018** *3.3 Vivino Rating **\$40.00**
– Marlborough, Grape Varietals – Pinot Noir
Smells of strawberries, jam, oak, vanilla and also of eucalyptus. It was intense, rounded in flavour with black berries being predominant.
- R9. Mt Monster Shiraz 2016** *3.5 Vivino Rating **\$40.00**
– South Australia, Grape Varietals – Shiraz
Big rich and bold ripe dark berries with a wacky of chocolate and a hint of spice with a firm finish
