— 2016. South Australia  
Soft and fresh, this wine is quite light bodied yet delivers plenty of ripe red and black fruit. 175ml: £6.50 / 250ml: £9.00 / Carafe: £18.00

— 2016. Rioja, Spain  
An elegant wine with balanced spicy aromas, with hints of red fruits and a hint of vanilla oak, underpinned by a fine tannic structure. 175ml: £9.75 / 250ml: £13.75 / Carafe: £27.50

**Pinot Noir Reserva, Veramonte**

— 2016. Casa Blanca Valley, Chile

**Cypres de Climens, Grand Vin du  
Sauternes**

— 2012. Bordeaux, France  
Aromas of white blossom, apricot, pineapple and lime, backed by richness and a fresh balance to finish. 100ml: £12.50 / Bottle: £46.00

**Ricioto di Soave Classico, Bolla**

— 2010/11. Veneto, Italy  
An intense, acacia honeyed aroma and flavour with subtle oak hints on the finish. 100ml: £9.00 / Bottle: £44.00

**Casa Vista, Cabernet Sauvignon**

— 2017. Central Valley, Chile  
This classic deep purple Cabernet Sauvignon has ripe plum and damson fruit aromas. The fruit combines with light tannins on the palate to give a smooth, gently spiced finish. 175ml: £6.75 / 250ml: £9.50 / Carafe: £18.75

Cru**

— 2012/13. Bordeaux, France  
This wine offers cherry perfumes and hints of toast. Soft and balanced tannins with juicy red fruits on the finish. Bottle: £58.00

— 2017. Peninsula de Setúbal, Portugal  
This beautiful Portuguese red wine has a ruby colour with violet rim. Red fruit aroma such as strawberries. Young, soft and balanced in the mouth. Bottle: £34.00

**The Guv'nor, Tempranillo**

— NV. Spain  
Made to a fruit-driven style it shows notes of vanilla from a short period of oak ageing. This is a no-nonsense wine, which shows plenty of rich, ripe, sweet red and dark fruit flavours and a juicy finish. 175ml: £7.25 / 250ml: £10.50 / Carafe: £20.75

— 2016. Yecla – Murcia, Spain

— 2013. Riberia del Duero, Spain

— 2017. Valdepenas, Spain  
This particular blend produces a refreshing aromatic wine with notes of apples and tropical fruits.

A soft green apple scented Chardonnay that demonstrates its unoaked nature with plenty of fruit flavours on the palate.

— 2017. Western Australia, Australia

— 2016. Loire Valley, France  
Full and round at first, followed by a sensation of crispness. A touch of anise lingering. Notes of gooseberries, grapefruit and mineral.

A rich aromatic bouquet. Notes of white fruit, citrus and fennel with a light toastiness from aging in oak. Supple, fresh and balanced on the finish.
