Nebbiolo

Floral, and light spices, with a finish of rose, violet and white pepper. In the mouth it is fresh, lively, harmonious; it is soft, elegant, full-bodied with a very long and juicy aftertaste. Reminiscent of freshly macerated red berries, raspberry and currant.

Nose of wild flowers and aromatic herbs, citrus and exotic fruits. In the mouth, the sapidity and minerality that refresh the sip and continue for a long time in the finish, with notes of acacia honey, sage and rosemary.
