Peshwari - Area in Pakistan.

Chettinadu - Southern Area of India.

Railway Lamb Curry - From the Colonial era in India when chefs cooked on the railways during long journeys on the train.

Jaffna - Northern Area of Sri Lanka.

Hoppers - Also known as Appam - fermented rice and coconut bowl shaped pancake. Very popular in Sri Lanka and Southern India.

Dosa - fermented rice and lentil pancake. Staple dish all over India.

Nelore – Origins from the Indian State of Andra Pradesh.

Kerala - South Western Area of India.

Falooda – found all over the Sub Continent, also spelt Faluda. Very similar to an Ice Cream float.

Upcountry - Hill area of Sri Lanka (Nuwara Eliya, Hatton, Kandy).

Gobi 65- Popular street food snack in India, made from Cauliflower florets. The original recipe had 65 types of chilli hence the name.

Bhindi - Okra.

Kurkuri - means crunchy.

Nethili - anchovy.

Pol - Sinhalese for coconut.

Seeni - Sinhalese for sugar.

Hot Butter Cuttlefish - Very popular Dish that can be found almost anywhere in the Commercial Capital of Sri Lanka.

Pirattal - Tamil for "tossed & turned".

Varuval - dry cooked curry from the Tamil nadu region.

Attukal - also known as "Paya" which means leg/foot.

Hara Payz - spring onion.

Mulligatawny - originates from the Tamil words milagu and tanni which translates "pepper water".
